			<u>WEATHER SUMMARY.</u> Generally fair conditions with well broken upper cloud, occurring frequently by night in the latter half of the month, but on no occasion being present all day. No rain was recorded. <u>Cloud.</u> First half of the month was characterised by variable cloud, frequently cloudless. From 15th onwards thin variable patches of stratus were reported during the night on all but three occasions, base 1000-2000 feet but falling very low on night of 20th-21st. <u>Visibility.</u> Generally moderate with a minimum of 2 miles early on the 23rd. <u>Winds.</u> Generally light to moderate but predominating between NW and SW with a tendency to be W.S.W. during the day and evening, and NW during the night.
